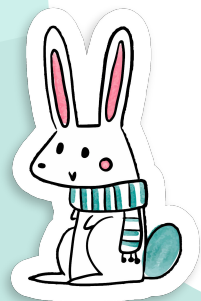


Camron* Vaughn

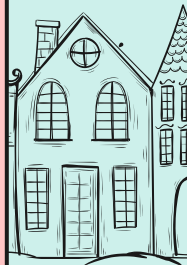
Ibrahim Faisal

Ms. Wolfman | 3rd Grade

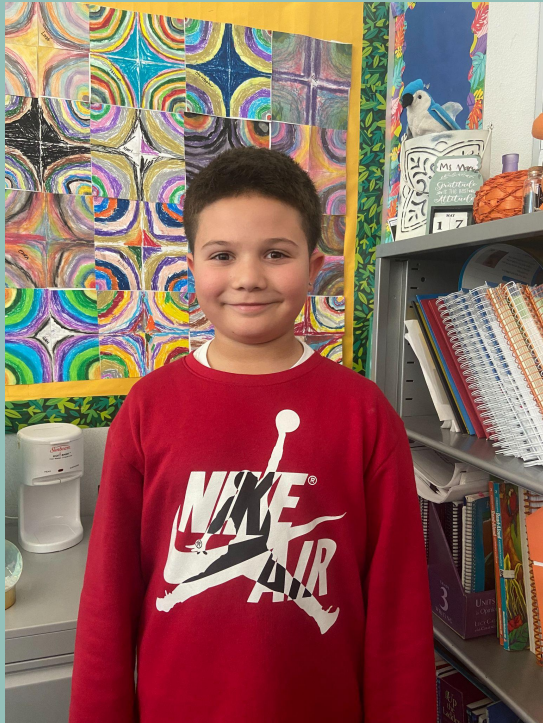


Joao is a very responsible student. He comes to school every day prepared and ready to learn. He does his best and always turns in his work completed and on time.
