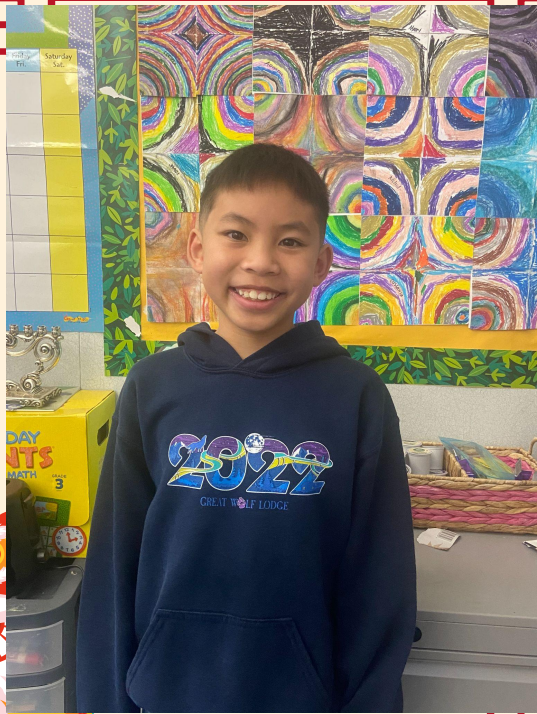
Ms. Tran | 2nd Grade

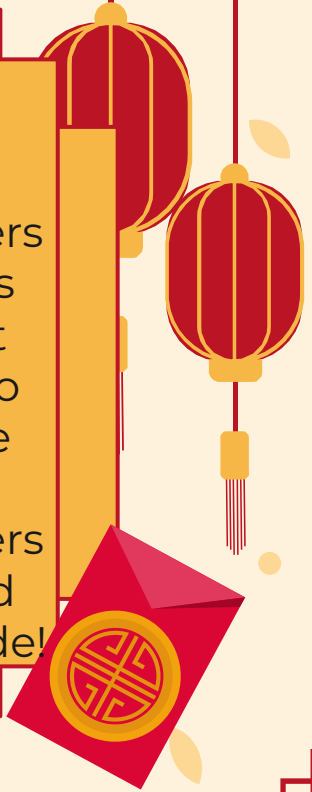


Jase Saribay

Ms. Marker | 3rd Grade



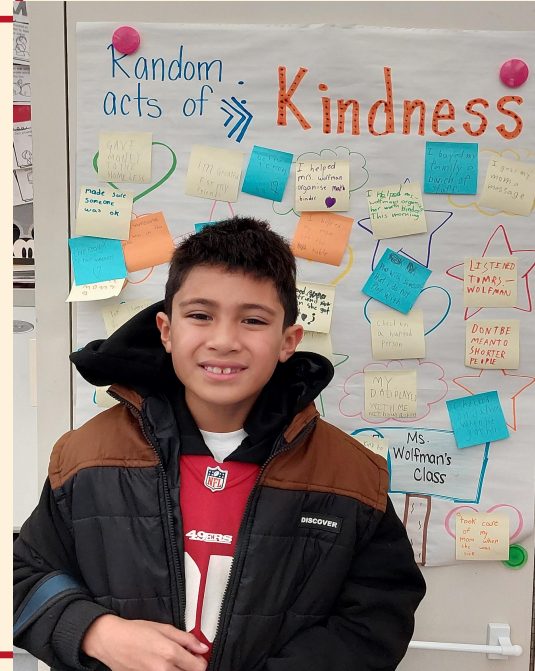
