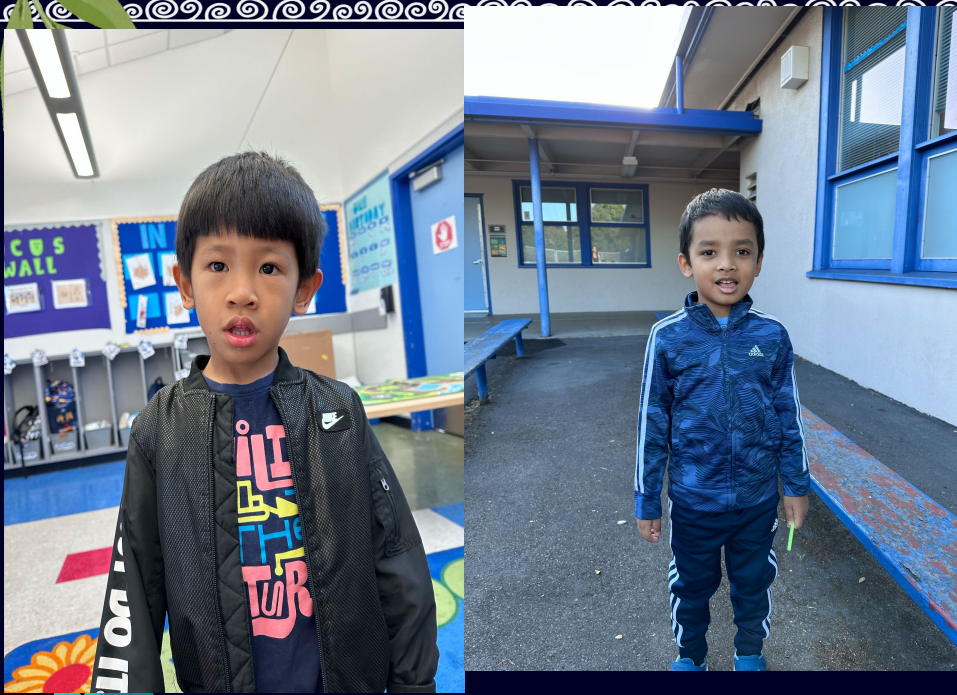

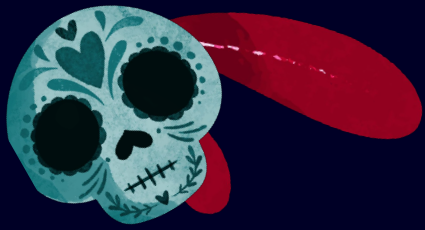
BEING HELPFUL

Ms. Gutierrez | Kindergarten

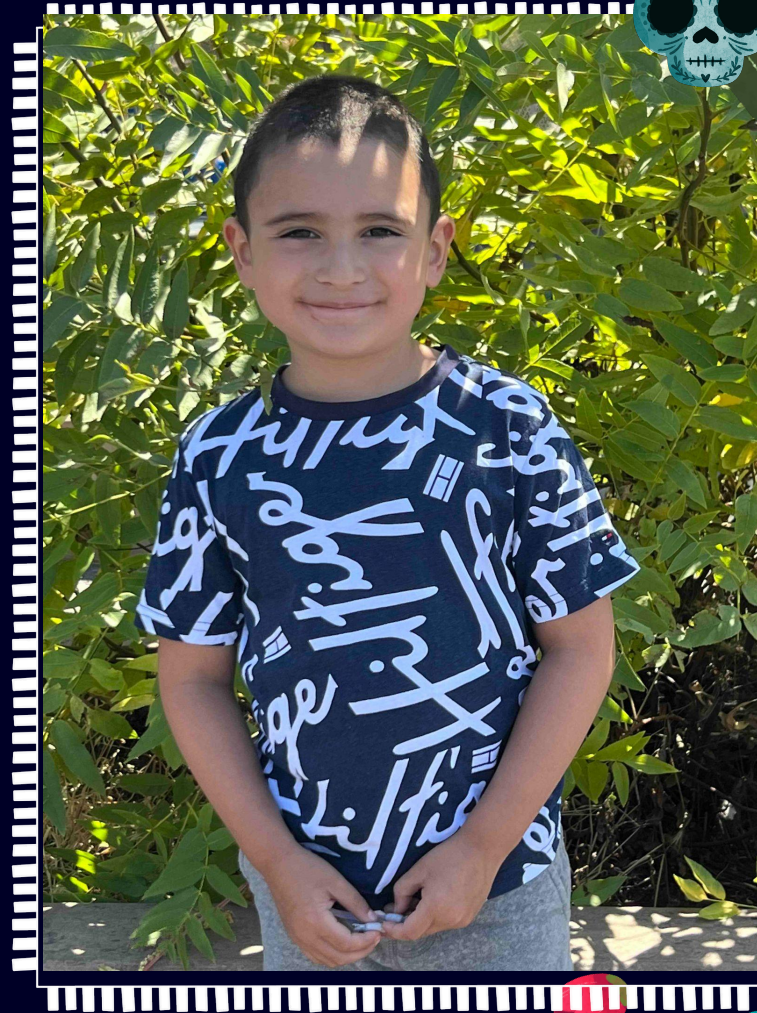

LIVIA BATTINO AND KLAY BACAY

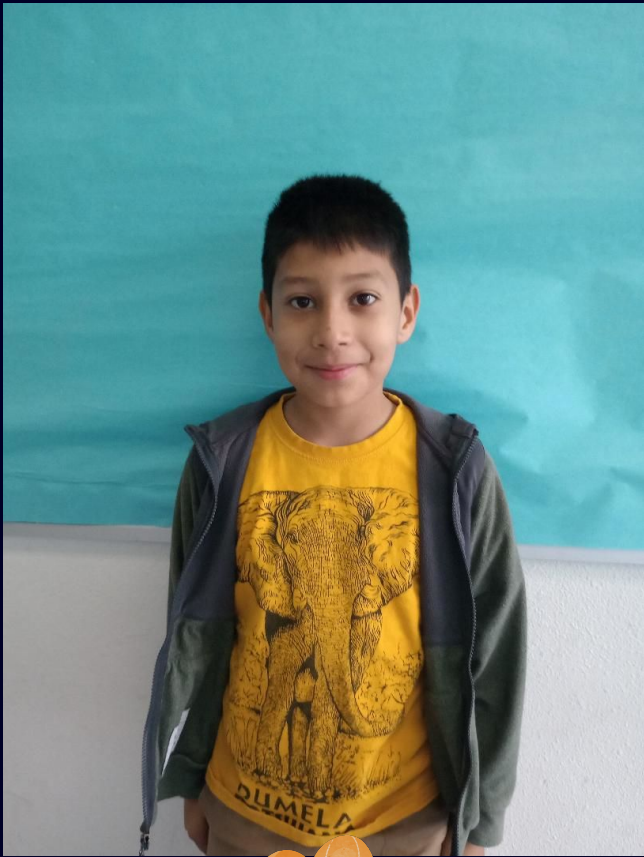
Ms. Marker | 3rd Grade

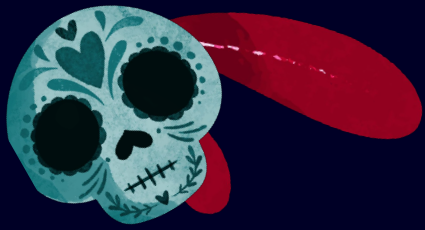


JASON RODRIGUEZ LUCERO

MOHIB MALIK

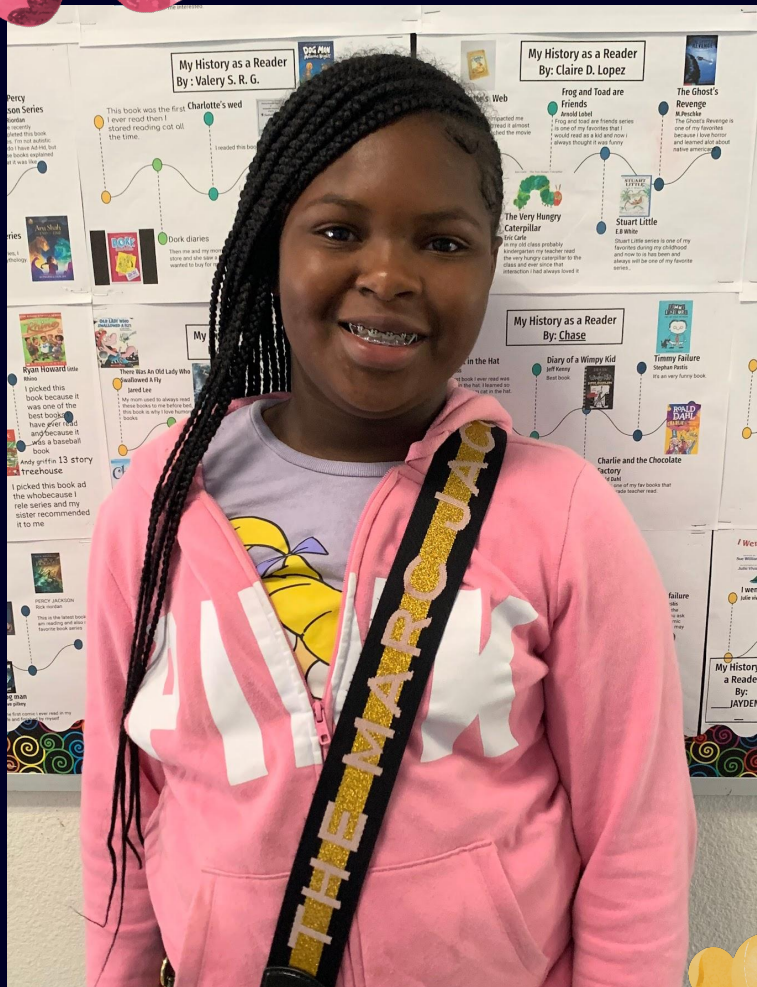
Ms. Papps | 4th & 5th Grade
