Services Provided


Mental Health Services: Includes crisis intervention, grief counseling, stress management, and general counseling on relationship issues, violence in the community, eating disorders, alcohol and drug abuse, and anger management for individual and group counseling.

Medical Services: Includes the provision of physicals, sports exams, first aid, family planning, screening and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), immunizations, and referrals to outside physicians and hospitals.

Health Education: Focused on pregnancy prevention, HIV/ STI prevention, human sexuality, and substance abuse prevention.

Youth Advisory Board: The Health and Wellness Center Youth Advisory Board help to envision and develop various ways of promoting health resources to the school and outside community as well as provide valuable information about the opinions, needs, wants and attitudes around Health Center services.
