Services Provided

Counseling & Crisis Support: Individual and group counseling, crisis assessment, are provided by the Y-Team (YMCA) and Bay Area Community Resources (BACR).


Dental Services: Offers exams, cleaning, and sealants to students regardless if they have insurance.
