#### **Phil Playle**

Class of 1960, Mayor of Fairmont Avenue

If you want to know what's happening in El Cerrito, then the person to talk to is Phil Playle. He operates Phil's Barber Shop on Fairmount Avenue that was once operated by his father. He's still in touch with many alumni of ECHS and chats with them when they visit his shop.

Phil w as born in Providence Hospital in Oakland on October 10, 1941. An only child, Phil w as born and raised in  $\Box$  Cerrito. When he w as a child, his family lived in the rooms behind the barber shop. He attended Harding  $\Box$  ementary through the sixth grade and Portola Middle for grades seventh to ninth. He then attended  $\Box$  Cerrito High School and graduated in 1960. As a child, he remembers cleaning the barber shop and w ashing cars. His morning task w as to turn on the barber pole.

After high school graduation, Phil attended Contra Costa College with Sylvester Greenwood. Their football team excelled and had a record of 28 w ins and no losses. After that, Phil attended Fresno State. In 1966, Phil married his first wife, Babette. They were married for six years until their divorce in 1972. Their sons were born in 1969 and 1970. Babette passed away in 2007. In 1975, Phil married Anne Playle who was from Switzerland. In 1982, she was shot and killed at her job on Solano Avenue during an attempted robbery. Today, his sons are grown and far away, but he talks to them frequently.

Phil remembers that ECHS was fun. He never missed a day of school. Claude Samples was the principal during Phil's time. Those were the days. Sports were very big. Dick Hunn was the baseball coach. El Collins and Paul Parker coached football and basketball. Phil remembers that there were lots of good teachers at ECHS including Mrs. Ryberg for English, Mr. Etcheverry for Chemistry, Duke Dew itt for Woodshop, and Vivian Weatherhead for Math. During Phil's days at ECHS, the cafeteria was located in what was later known as the dungeon. Phil also remembers George Gates, who founded El Cerrito Tennis in 1939/1940.

Currently, Phil lives in Pinole and enjoys going to the gym every day. He is on his reunion committee and still enjoys looking through his many yearbooks. His son Chris works for the City of Santa Rosa and enjoys "doing it all". His son, Noel, lives in Puerto Esconditio, Mexico and Brazil, where he surfs, does photography, and makes surfing movies.
