Remembering James Morehouse and James Mitchell

James Morehouse July 17, 1936 ~ April 7, 2010 Resident of Richmond Mr. James Morehouse w as a student counselor and w orked with \Box Cerrito High School for 35 years. Married to his beloved wife Oveida Morehouse for over 50 years, and lovingly remembered by his 4 sons Lessley, James Jr., Darnell and Paul Morehouse.

James "Pops" Mitchell Sept. 30, 1965 ~ April 15, 2010 Resident of Richmond Maybe it was the simplicity of his nickname. Perhaps it w as his infectious smile that made people notice. To some it w as the w ay he could swing a baseball bat or shed blocks on the football field. All remember his kind heart. Left to embrace those memories and many more are family and friends of James "Pops" Mitchell, the former El Cerrito prep legend who died unexpectedly last Thursday of a heart attack. He was 44. Mitchell's health had been in decline in recent years. He suffered from Type I diabetes and received regular dialysis treatments. Born in Richmond, Mitchell was arguably one of the best athletes to ever wear an ⊟ Cerrito uniform. He played baseball and football, earning recognition from several publications for his stellar play. He also coached at ⊟ Cerrito and worked in the school district as a site supervisor for nearly a decade. "Pops" earned a baseball scholarship to USC and eventually played in the Cleveland Indians organization. Mitchell, who graduated from El Cerrito High School in 1984, was named California's Mr. Baseball by Cal-Hi Sports. A year earlier, he played on a team that w ent 27-1. One year, Mitchell hit two home runs at Cerrito Vista Park in ⊟ Cerrito that scouts estimated traveled nearly 450 feet from home plate. In football, opposing teams double- and triple-teamed him to no avail. He was intensely competitive in athletics and other endeavors he enjoyed like playing dominoes. A fund has been established to help his sons. Contributions to the "Pops" Memorial fund can be made in care of "Shelley Mitchell" at Chase Bank, 12121 San Pablo Ave., Richmond. The account number is 2945893440. Survivors include his spouse Shalan; sons James and Devin; sisters Angela, Lasonda and Shelley; and parents James Sr. and Rebbie Mitchell. Extended relatives include nieces and nephews D'Naya, Dahnzhay, Iyana, Wanya, Kiana, Shayanne, Trey, Jazzmine and Jordan.
