# John Gioia, ECHS Class of 1975

John Gioia grew up in the Mira Vista area of Richmond. His father, a civics teacher at Kennedy High School, didn't drive because he was visually handicapped. So, John usually rode his bike to school at  $\Box$  Cerrito High School, riding along Richmond Avenue and Everett Street after meeting up with friends around Potrero Avenue. On rainy days, John rode the bus. Today, John is a Contra Costa County Supervisor and a major champion of public transit and the environment.

John attended school in San Francisco for grades 1 to 5. In sixth grade, he attended the former Del Mar Elementary School in El Cerrito and then Portola for grades 7 to 9. After that he attended El Cerrito High School, graduating in 1975. He entered college at UC Berkeley, where he received a BA degree in Political Science in 1979 and a JD from Boalt Hall School of Law in 1982. While at Boalt, he worked as a half time staffer for then Contra Costa County Supervisor Tom Pow ers and also got a taste for politics by working on Supervisor Pow er's 1978 Campaign.

After receiving his law degree, John practiced business and land use law in San Francisco and then moved his office to Richmond. He also ran political campaigns and did polling and developed campaign strategies for candidates throughout the Bay Area in the 1980s. In 1988 John was elected to the Board of the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD). After being reelected in 1992 and 1996, John successfully ran for the Contra Costa Board of Supervisors. In 2002 and 2006 he was unopposed when he ran for reelection.

Grow ing up, John w as a good student and he "had to be on good behavior because his father knew 且 Cerrito High teachers". He channeled his involvement into a number of activities, including playing the violin in the school orchestra and running cross country and track. In the 10th grade, he had Hale Roach as a cross country and track coach. In grades 11-12, he had Jim Brooks for both track and cross country. John

recalls that the early 1970s was a good period at ECHS. The school had unity and pride and many students went to Cal.

John remembers having a great time with sports, although that often meant he missed other activities including the Junior Prom and Senior Ball. These were the same years that the Oakland A's won the World Series (1972 to 1974). John hung out with the track and cross country runners, a diverse group of students. Barry Cromarti was a jumper who later became a Richmond Planning Director.

John remembers how the Gaucho name got started. Coach Hale Roach and his wife lived on Colusa Avenue behind ⊟ Cerrito High School when the school was built in the 1940's. Roach's wife got the idea for the Gaucho name from UC Santa Barbara which also is called the Gauchos.

The announcer for home track meets w as Sandy Berman, w ho w as also John's 12th grade math teacher. If John acted up in class, Mr. Berman w ould intentionally mispronounce his name. Some of John's other teachers included Ted Beck for Physics, John Rossi for Government and Carol Liu for American Experience. Carol Liu is now a Los Angeles area state senator.

Today John is busy with the many responsibilities and activities related to being a county supervisor and also his family. John's father passed away in 1987 at the age of 57, a year before John was elected to EBMUD. His mother, an immigrant from Italy, died of cancer soon after John was elected to the Board of Supervisors in 1998. John has a half sister from his mother's first marriage.

John lives with his wife, Jennifer Peck, and children in Richmond. Jennifer is the Executive Director of the Bay Area Partnership for Children and Youth. John has a son, Christopher, born in 1992, with his first wife, Charo. Christopher was a star track and cross country runner at Albany High School. He will be attending Cal in the fall. John and Jennifer have a daughter, Emilia, who was born in 2004.
