NANI, a student thesis film, was inspired, directed and co-written by Justin Tipping.

Justin graduated from ECHS in 2003 and did his undergraduate work in Film and Media Studies at UC Santa Barbara. He received his MFA in directing from the American Film Institute (AFI) in 2012.



His career began with intensity, filming locally with help from family and friends. He relocated to Los Angeles in 2008 and started directing and editing in the commercial and music video arena where his work gained recognition on MTV, VHI, FUSE and Discovery Channel networks.

NANI world-premiered in competition at the Berlin International Film Festival 2012 and thereafter screened at over 40 film festivals around the world, winning multiple awards. The prestigious Student Oscar was awarded to Justin by The Academy last June. Justin is also the recipient of the
