


Coach Hale Roach's papers.

Papers donated from Mike Roach, Coach Roach's son and the Roach family.







On Sunday, November 9, 2014, El Cerrito High School inducted the class of

2014 into its Athletic Hall of Fame. This is the fourth class to be inducted into the Hall.

More than 350 people attended the Hall of Fame ceremony in the new gymnasium. Photographs and newspaper articles were displayed on storyboards in the foyer.

Included in the 350 guests, were 26 Hall of Fame athletes and coaches.

Twenty five athletes, one coach, one special category, and three athletic teams were inducted into the Hall. Twenty one of 27 inductees attended the ceremony.
