Offensive Lineman:
Aaron Banks, El Cerrito

What he did: The 6-foot, 325-pound lineman paved the way for an offense that averaged 29.4 points per game as a senior in 2016. A first team all Bay Area News Group Selection, the four-star recruit committed to Notre Dame over other finalists that included Cal, Michigan, Nebraska, Oregon, Tennessee and UCLA.

Where he is now: After spending his freshman season on a scout team, Banks played in all 13 games as a sophomore in 2018 and made his first career start against Navy. Entrenched at left guard this fall, he closed out a 10-2 regular season with a 45-24 win at Stanford.

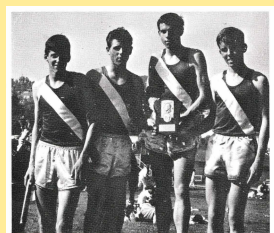

Excerpt from a classmate

El Cerrito High in the Forties: a Snapshot

THE TIMES. As the 1940s began, El Cerrito was still in the grip of The Great Depression. But on a promising first day, graduates of Fairmont, Harding, and Kensington grammar schools gathered at their new high school and warily sized each other up. Money was scarce, which was why even for that important event, few of them wore new clothes and most carried bag lunches. War raged everywhere except in America, and the Japanese aircraft carriers which would destroy much of the U.S. Pacific fleet a year later were getting set. Times were bleak. Still, for those new seventh graders there was a silver lining. El Cerrito was to be a junior-senior high school. So they would grow up together for six years. Lifelong friendships would begin on that day.
