

## Parent-Student On-Line Course Selection Instructions Helpful Tips/Reminders:

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
Course selections will be available online through the Parent Portal. If you have not created a PowerSchool account, you will need to logon at [wccusd.powerschool.com](http://wccusd.powerschool.com) and create an account. Student will be given a packet of information that will consist of Course Sheet Selection, Online Course Selection Instructions and Parent/Guardian access to PowerSchool. It is important to work with your student to complete the Course Selection Worksheet, select appropriate courses complete online selection and **return course sheets to school by March 14<sup>th</sup>**.

Prior to starting the online process, please review the Course Selection Sheet 2015-16, front and back. It is important to complete the course sheet prior to selecting classes online. The completed course sheet is **due back March 14<sup>th</sup>**.

### How To Select Classes For 2015-16 Online via PowerSchool

STEP 1: While on the Internet, type the following into your web address line:

STEP 2: While on the PowerSchool log-in page, enter the following information:

40 credits of Social Science are required for graduation and CSU/UC admission. Courses with an AP (Advanced Placement) designation cover the same concepts as the preparatory class, though move at an accelerated pace. Please select accordingly.

40 credits of English are required for graduation and CSU/UC admission. An ADV course covers the same concepts as a preparatory class, though moves at an accelerated pace. Please select accordingly.

On the right side of the screen, you will see that each subject area has either a green check mark or a red exclamation point.



If a subject area has a red exclamation point to the right, it means that it is a REQUIRED subject area and you MUST select a course or course in that area.



The green check mark means that if the subject area selection has been successfully identified.
