This report presents a brief overview of CBOC activities in our ongoing effort to perform the committee's duties as outlined in the Ed Code.

Dear President Groves, Honorable Trustees, Dr. Harter and Staff:
The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee is a comprised of dedicated volunteers representing the West Contra Costa Unified School *Community*. We currently have a total of 17 members.

At the July 15 CBOC meeting the Data Review Subcommittee was tasked with drafting a response, from the CBOC, to the June 2015, Grand Jury Report. The Data Review Subcommittee met on August 11 and drafted its responses to the Grand Jury Report. Those responses will be brought before the full body on August 26. We believe that the Grand Jury Findings and Recommendations identified areas of concern that existed in the years prior to 2015. We feel that improvements have been made and we want to acknowledge those changes. This response will accompany the District's response, which is due by September 11.

The Audit Subcommittee has formed a "Working Group" to define and establish financial reports that can better reflect the status of the Bond Program.
